Mat 25 :34-36 "Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. Illness: Thanks for supporting us in prayer. We have had a much better month but Lottie still suffers from repeated ear infections. She has seen a specialist and we are monitoring it.

Climate Change: The rain has eased on the coast a little but has been causing problems in the mountains. A key inter-

section in Quito will be closed for several months after a swollen river caused a huge crater to emerge, destroying the carriageway. Martin has produced a video about HCJB's response to the floods. This is now in Spanish and German as well as English. Go to YouTube.com and search for HCJB or the GlobalHarry channel. Martin is now involved in a post operation appraisal of the water filtration plants that were installed. HCJB is considering whether the area of emergency water supplies is one in which we can be involved again in future disaster situations.

Ruth: Ruth continues to contribute to work in the office, particularly looking at the educational aspects of what we do. She is also planning for the two work teams and the various visitors we are expecting. Whilst doing this she still coordinates family life and all the hospitality we offer in the home. She is preparing to teach 6 weeks of chemistry starting in September at Alliance Academy High School (a maternity cover).

Carabuela Water Project: Work has now begun on protecting the springs and we are just beginning to get to know some people in the community. Ruth and Lottie were able to spend a day there recently whilst Martin checked out progress.
